

# Ultra-xsDetect Description

Ultra-xsDetect is a daily report that is generated at the end of each business day. Each day a program scan a set of index ETFs and the short, ultra and ultra-short versions of the ETFs. The program calculated the 8/20 Moving Average crossing of each component.

The list of ETFs tracked are in the following table:

An example of a daily report follows:

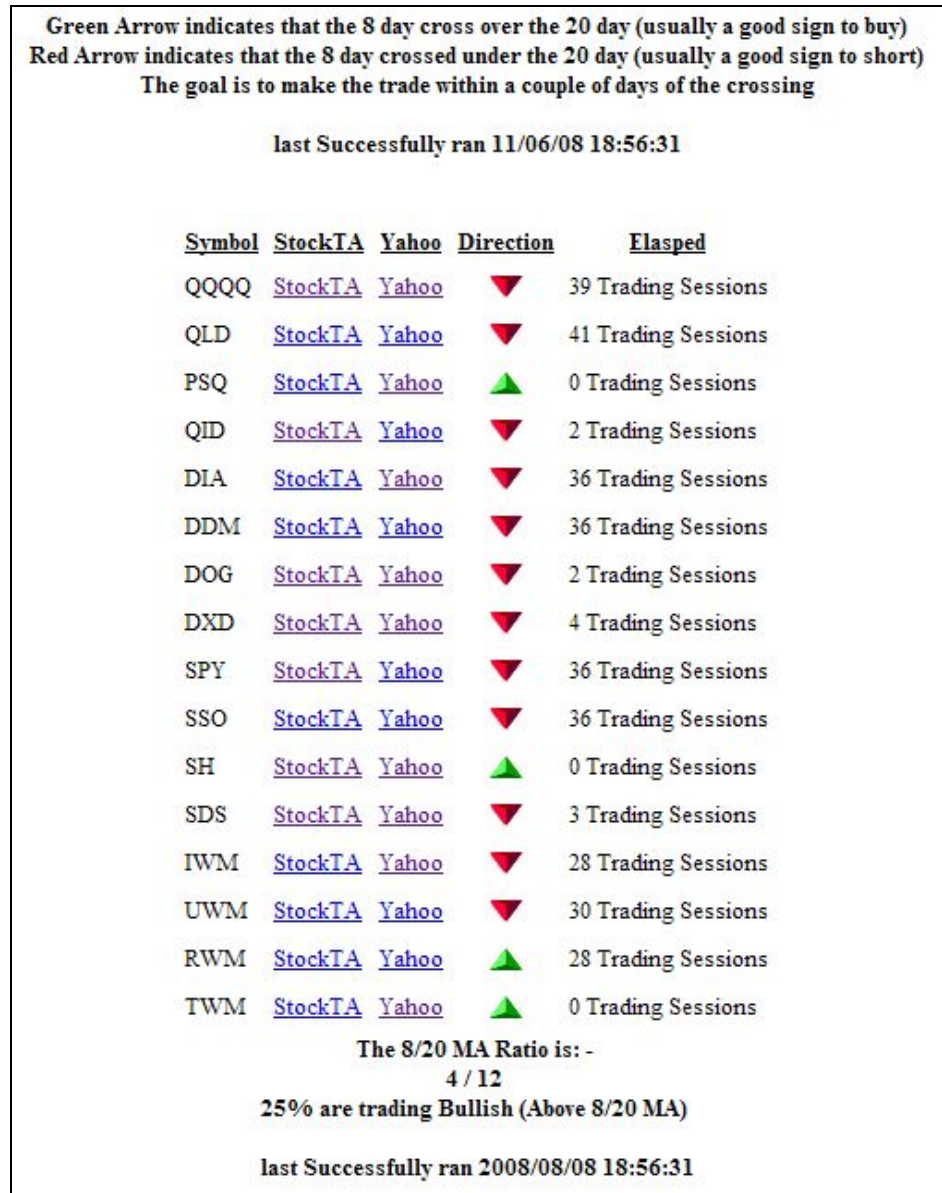


Figure 1, Ultra-xsDetect Daily Report

As you will note, the symbols PSQ, SH and TWM shows values of 0 Trading Sessions. That indicates that the 8/20 MA crossed over today. If the arrow is red, the 8 crossed below the 20 day MA, if the arrow is green, the 8 crossed above the 20 day MA.

Values greater than 0 are the number of trading days since the last transition occurred. The hyperlinks to StockTA and Yahoo will bring you to charts on the specific symbol.
